Housing (Linen)	Optional	¥5,000-¥8,000	cash	Cash&carry (temporary linen shop at the residence hall) is available on the arrival day.

Housing (Utility)	Mandatory	¥6,000-7,000/month (Estimated)	automatic withdrawal from Japanese bank account	Utility for the common place and individual room will be withdrawn automatically from Japanese bank account every month.
Internet	Optional	¥1,800/month (subject to change)	cash or credit card	Students make a contract with a provider and pay individually to the provider.
National Health Insurance	Mandatory	about ¥1,100-1,500/month	cash	The bill will be mailed to each student. Students pay individually in cash at the convenience store.
Commute Pass (from dorm to campus)	Optional	¥10,280/month ¥29,300/3 month	cash	Hitotsubashi Gakuen Station (Residence Hall Ikkyo-Ryo) to Kunitachi Station (Hitotsubashi campus) One-way train fare is ¥310.
