




Students who have not yet entered Japan or have been officially permitted to attend classes online by Hitotsubashi University may take classes online.


Depending on the situation of the students, the mode of class delivery may change after course registration period by consultation.

Introduction to Japanese Language

⇒ 3 class hours (3 credits)

⇒ an introductory course of Japanese

⇒ designed for students who will stay in Japan

listening skills necessary for simple
conversation in everyday life

NOTE:

1) ALL the courses are taught by the "direct method", which means that classes are conducted only in Japanese.

2) Enrollment for each course is limited to the classroom capcity. 15 students for BJ1 and 36 students for IJL. (Being determined by web lottery)


3) We take attendance very seriously.


If students miss some classes, it will be difficult for them to catch up and successfully complete the course.

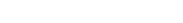
## **Exams**







