Type of accommodation offered *Exchange students are <u>required</u> to live on-campus.	 All exchange students are placed in residence halls that remain open during university breaks and that have kitchen facilities. These options can vary based on availability. Exchange students can be placed anywhere on-campus and usually live in the Quads, Carolina International House at Maxcy College (Maxcy), Bates-West or any of the Horseshoe apartments. Housing is guaranteed but preferences are not. Meal plans	UofSC offers several meal plan options at a variety of on-campus dining locations. Meal plans are <u>not</u> required.
