Application	Online application (application details will be sent to the nominated students directly). The necessary personal information may be forwarded to the Austrian Federal Ministry for Europe, Integration and Foreign Affairs (BMEIA) in order to support the student's application for a visa/residence permit.
Language Requirements	Exchange students do not have to submit any language certificate (exceptions: Translation, English Studies, Business, Economics, Statistics), but knowledge of German is recommended. Please note that in many fields of study most of the courses are taught in German.
