Are exchange students required to purchase a compulsory medical insurance plan?	Yes. Regardless of any existing coverage the student has at home university or in home country, all international students are required to purchase the international student insurance. The insurance premium is RMB 800 per academic year. (RMB 400/semester)

Is purchase of medical insurance recommended?	Purchase of medical insurance or accident insurance in home country as a supplement to Compulsory Medical Insurance is recommended.	
Visa Requirements		
Are exchange students required to obtain a student visa?	Yes. Chinese Student Visa type: X1 or X2. X1 visa – two semester exchange X2 visa – one semester exchange (X2 holders are able to apply for an extra enter chance during the exchange)	
If yes, what are the procedures?	Refer to visa requirements on local consulates' websites.	
Is there any physical examination needed?	Students must complete physical examination after enrollment at Fudan if they stay in the mainland of China for more than 180 days. Physical exam costs RMB660 yuan and Resident Permit costs RMB400 yuan. Physical examination after enrollment at Fudan is recommended because the verification of home physical examination record will probably fail due to different physical examination system.	
Are exchange students allowed to do off-campus internship?	General Advanced and Senior Advanced students may apply for off-campus internship, but need to submit internship notation in advance. Chinese language students MAY NOT apply for off-campus internship.

Is university-administered accommodation available for exchange students?	Yes. (Availability in 2023 Fall is to be determined.) Housing fee and Utilities will be counted separately.
Is availability guaranteed?	Not guaranteed. Exchange students apply online by themselves.
What is the application procedure?	Apply online at http://www.fso.fudan.edu.cn/en/ The E-Booking System will be available one month after admission, no earlier application allowed.
Is accommodation available over semester breaks?	Available only for exchange students staying for a whole academic year (two semesters). Over semester breaks accommodation fees will be counted by days.

Course-related Information	
How many teaching weeks are there in a semester?	18 weeks per semester (16 teaching weeks + 2 exam weeks)
How is a credit point defined?	One instruction hour (45 minutes) per week throughout the semester stands for one credit at Fudan. An academic semester includes 18 weeks.

Can students extend their exchange stint?	Yes. Application deadlines: May 1 (for Fall Semester) or Nov. 1 (for Spring Semester)
If yes, please advise application deadline and procedures.	Procedures: get permission from Study Abroad Office of home institution first and then apply to the Office of Global Partnerships at Fudan for extension.
Restricted program or courses (not open to exchange students)	According to agreements clauses. Other restrictions include the following: MBA courses, LLM courses, medical courses, special programs in faculties (e.g. International Cultural Exchange School), undergraduate courses in medicine. EMA courses are available for “Senior Advanced students”; other graduate-level courses are not available to exchange students.
Courses that are only available in one particular semester	Spring and Fall course schedules are different.
What is normal exchange student load per semester?	6-15 credits for one semester (2-8 courses) (10 credits per semester on average)
Are students allowed to take cross-faculty courses? If yes, are there any restrictions?	Yes. As long as the courses can be registered online successfully.
Most favored faculties?	International Cultural Exchange School; School of Economics/Management/ International Relations & Public Affairs/Social Development & Public Policy etc.
About final transcripts.	Official transcripts will be sent to home university at the beginning of the following term (electronic copies, usually around mid-September to receive transcripts of spring semester and mid-March of fall semester). We cannot provide any official transcripts earlier than that. If you require hard copies please contact our mobility office at incoming@fudan.edu.cn . Please arrange your personal schedule (graduation, internship etc.) carefully before applying to the exchange programs.
