


How to Register


Students should register via Campus
Education Learning System (CELS) online.

Undergraduate Exchange Students may apply to the First and Second Web Lottery.


Graduate Exchange Students, Research Students and Regular Graduate Students may apply to the Second Web Lottery.

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Withdrawal (W) of your registered course(s)

If you have registered for a course and decided to withdraw from it after the registration period, you must process the withdrawal using the CELS Online Registration System during the withdrawal period.

After that period, you will not be able to withdraw. Failure then to complete the assigned (assessment) tasks will result in a Fail grade (F).

Tuesday, September 26 – Monday, October 2

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



Self-registration on MANABA is different from the CELS course registration. To enroll in the course as a regular student, you should complete the course registration procedure on CELS.

Students who win the Web Lottery will be automatically registered on MANABA.


NOTE! After the registration period is closed, all students except regular students enrolled in the course will be automatically deleted from MANABA.

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
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


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








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





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








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





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









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


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3.4. Grading

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Attendance
No audit is allowed. Students who want to attend a Japanese learning class, are required to register.
We take attendance very strictly. Being absent or late to class will be penalized with a total score reduction.
Keep in touch with the class instructors if you have any problems with attendance.

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If you are late for less than 20 minutes, you will be reduced by 20%. If you are late or leave the class for either 20 minutes or more after the class has started, you will also be reduced by 30%.

## Homework:

- You will be given homework assignments on a regular basis.
   Check the course schedule and meet deadlines.
- You should submit your homework at the beginning of the class following the instructor's directions. No submission after the deadline is accepted. It will NOT be marked on your score if submitted after due date.
- Incomplete or poorly done homework will NOT be accepted.
   If more than half of the assignment is incorrect, it will not be marked.

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Quizzes

- Quizzes will be usually given at the beginning of the class via manaba. If you come late, you will miss quizzes.
- No make up for quizzes.

## **Exams**

- Midterm and Final Exams include Speaking, Listening, and Reading Tests.
- Final Exam also includes a presentation.
- You may make up for midterm, and final exam ONLY IF YOU HAVE SERIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES. In this case you should submit a written explanation and inform the <u>coordinator</u> as soon as possible.
- Exams should be made up within a week of the scheduled time and will NOT be given prior to the scheduled test dates. The score on a make-up exam will be reduced by 10 %.

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NOTE:

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We take attendance very strictly.

If students miss some classes, it will be difficult for them to catch up and successfully complete the course.


How do we entry for the classes?

Submit "Entry Sheet for BJ1/IJL course" on manaba "Surveys" page.


\*Only students who have already decided taking the class.
