




- Supplementary materials will be distributed before classes via MANABA.






Download the schedules from the "Resources" on the BJ2 or CJB manaba course page.

Attendance

- No audit is allowed. Students who want to attend Japanese learning classes are required to register.
- Being <u>absent or late</u> to class <u>will be penalized</u> with a total score reduction.
- Keep in touch with the class instructors if you have any problems with attendance.



Homework

- You will be given homework assignments on a regular basis. Refer to the course schedule and meet deadlines.
- You should submit your homework at the beginning of the class following the instructor's directions.

No submission after the deadline is accepted.

• Incomplete or incorrectly done homework will NOT be accepted and will be marked as 0.



Quizzes

- Quizzes will be held at the beginning of the class.
 If you come late, you will miss the quiz.
- No make up for quizzes.



Exams

- You may make up for midterm and final exams ONLY IF YOU HAVE SERIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES. In this case, you must submit a written explanation and inform the coordinator as soon as you can.
- Makeup exams need to be taken within a week after the scheduled exam date and will NOT be offered before the original test dates. The score for a makeup exam will be decreased by 10 %.

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- ALL the courses are taught using the "direct method," which means that classes are conducted <u>only in Japanese</u>.
- We have strict attendance rules.
 If students miss classes, it will be difficult to catch up and successfully finish the course.

FQA How do we pre-register for the classes? Submit "Students Information Sheet" on the manaba "Surveys" page. *Only students who have already decided to take the class. It is not the official course registration.

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FQA

Can we attend various classes during the first week? (Just try them in order to decide which class I would take.)

➤ Due to the registration system, YES.

However, if you miss a class, you will need to catch up on the lesson content on your own, as there will not be any extra classes for catching up.



FQA

My major class conflicts with the Japanese class. (i.e., Japanese Economics and BJ2 both are scheduled on the same day and same period) Is it possible to be absent from some classes in a week?

➤ <u>NO</u>. You must attend all classes. (5 classes a week for BJ2 or 3 classes a week for CJB)



FQA

Can we apply for the web lottery for both BJ2 and CJB?

(In order to decide which class to take and opt-out during the withdrawal period)

➤ Due to the registration system, Yes.

BUT!

Applying for both BJ2 and CJB, you may deprive other students of the opportunity to take Japanese classes. To avoid causing such issues, please carefully read the course materials (syllabus and schedule) and choose only one.
