Application process	<p>1st semester or year's exchange: 30th April 2024 2nd semester exchange: 1st October 2024</p> <p>After receiving the nomination from the student's home university, the students will receive the application instructions via email. Students are asked to await those instructions before starting the application.</p>
Courses for incoming exchange	<p><u>Courses open for Exchange Students</u></p> <p>Each year around July 15th the above link will be updated to read the program for next academic year. Only minor changes are to be expected. Courses available to incoming exchange students are taught on Master level. The min. workload is 24 ECTS / semester.</p>
Required language level	<p>English language requirement of 94 TOEFL iBT or 7 IELTS. Students from non-English speaking home countries are requested to hand in proof of proficiency with their application.</p>
