#### Pre-Departure

Visa Procedures	<ul> <li>Exchange students need to apply for X1 (long term/ more than 180 days) or X2 (short term/ less than 180 days) Visa. Other types of visas will not be accepted at registration.</li> <li>Those who hold an X1 Visa are required to apply for a Student Residence Permit within 30 days of entering China.
