- ♦1st Entry: Sep. 9 (9 a.m.) Sep. 10 (noon)
 - For courses offered in the autumn and/or winter quarters, winter intensive course Announcement of results: Sep. 11 (3 p.m.)
- ♦2nd Entry: Sep. 11 (5 p.m.) Sep. 12 (2 p.m.)

For courses offered in the autumn and/or winter quarters, winter intensive course Announcement of results: Sep. 12 (8 p.m.)

♦3rd Entry: Oct. 8 (noon) – Oct. 9 (noon)

For courses offered in the winter quarter and winter intensive course
Announcement of results: Oct. 10 (noon)

♦ 4th Entry: Dec. 9 (noon) – Dec. 10 (noon)

For winter intensive course Announcement of results: Dec. 11 (noon)

- Postgrad. students (Degree-seeking, Exchange, Research) can apply for the "2nd Entry" only.
- After all lotteries, the registration will be closed even if some courses still have seats remaining.

 Education Learning System (CELS).

Information on WEB Lotteries (1)

- Depending on the lottery period (1st Entry \sim 4th Entry), the courses eligible for the lottery differ (Autumn-Winter semester courses, Autumn quarter courses, Winter quarter courses, and Winter Intensive courses).
- Before applying for the lottery, check the following course registration rules carefully.
 - 1. Applicable Lottery Courses

To check if a course is a lottery course, refer to the syllabus on CELS.

→ Go to "Syllabus" > "Search for Specific Items"

Lottery courses are indicated with a "O" symbol in the "Online Registrator Lottery" section. (You can also use a search function to find courses subject to lotteries.)



Information on WEB Lotteries (2)

- If many students try to access CELS as the deadline approaches, you may not be able to complete your entry properly in time. There is no remedy even if you cannot complete your entry, so complete the procedures as early as possible.
- You can change/add/delete your choices as many times as you wish during each entry period only. (Be sure to confirm details of your registration at the end of your operation.)
- The 2nd, 3rd, and 4th lotteries are held only for courses that have seats remaining after the previous lottery. You are not allowed to register for any courses after the end of all lotteries even if some courses have seats remaining.
- Courses that you've won in the lotteries will be automatically registered. You are not allowed to change them to the other courses. You are not allowed to take any courses that you did not win, either. If you wish to withdraw from any of the courses you've won in the lottery, you may only delete them during the designated Course Withdrawal Period.



- Go to "Course" > "Pre-registration."




How to Apply for the Lottery (2)

- Courses with two classes per week are categorized into the course group of the first class. (e.g. A course with two classes on Mon. 2nd period and Thu. 2nd period → The course group is "Mon2")







Announcement of Lottery Results

Lottery results can be checked under "View Pre-Registrations" after the announcement.

Four essential check points

1. Do not forget to click on "Register"!

You will not be able to register for the courses unless you click on "Register"!


Otherwise your choices will not be saved.

Four essential check points

3. Be careful with overlapping day and period!

Make sure that courses registered in one course group do not overlap with courses registered in another course group.

Even if you apply for multiple courses on the same day and period,

- 1. you can win only one course per day and period,
- 2. no error message will be displayed when you apply.



Four essential check points

4. Be careful with language of instruction!

You cannot check the language of instruction on the WEB lottery screen. Do not judge by the language of the course title, as it is not related to the medium of instruction, but depends on the language displayed on CELS.

If you do not wish to take courses offered in Japanese, be sure to check the "Language" (J/E) in the syllabus before applying for the lottery to avoid applying for courses instructed in Japanese by mistake.

Repeat marks

If you retake a course that you have taken in a previous semester, it will be marked as "上書き."

If you retake the course, the grade will be overwritten.

- * The previous grade will not appear on your transcript, only the most recent grade will appear.
- * Even if the grade before the overwriting is higher, it is unconditionally rewritten to the grade after the overwriting.



Notes on the 2nd/3rd/4th lottery

The number of seats available for one course in the 2nd/3rd/4th lottery is the number of seats remaining after the previous lottery (lotteries).



- Courses with no remaining seats are excluded from the list of choices.
- You can win only one course per course group.
