<b>Academic information</b>	
<b>Full-time study</b>	Minimum study load per trimester: 3 UNE units at 6 credit points each Maximum study load per semester: 4 UNE units at 6 credit point each
<b>Credit system</b>	Credits points represent the relative course value of a unit which is offered by the University. A standard unit will usually equate to 6 credit points, to be studied within a single trimester. However, a unit may be assigned a higher credit point value if it represents a significant assessment load, or must be studied as a year-long unit (i.e. Honours). You are able to view the credit point values for each of your units within the relevant <a href="#">UNE Course Handbook</a> entries.
<b>Attendance requirements</b>	All students, including exchange students, studying in Australia on a student visa are expected to attend all scheduled classes and activities. Failure to comply with this could result in the cancellation of the Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) which may result in the subsequent cancellation of the student visa
<b>Unit/Subject selection</b>	At UNE, individual courses or subjects are called “units”. All nominated students should search <a href="#">UNE’s Course Handbook</a> to select the units they wish to study at UNE. Students should ensure they select units that are offered in the on campus mode in the trimester they are coming to study. Students should email their unit selection to <a href="mailto:studyabroad@une.edu.au">studyabroad@une.edu.au</a>
<b>Transcripts</b>	Official academic transcripts will be prepared at the end of the student’s final exchange trimester. UNE will issue digital copies. Student will need to arrange hard copies themselves.
<b>Academic requirements</b>	Students should normally be in at least their second year of academic study when they arrive at UNE to should have at least a C average or equivalent.
<b>English Language Requirements</b>	All applicants must meet UNE’s minimum English Language Requirements as specified at <a href="https://policies.une.edu.au/document/view-current.php?id=281">https://policies.une.edu.au/document/view-current.php?id=281</a>
<b>Application process</b>	Students are able to lodge an application for this course through UNE International’s <a href="#">‘Applying’</a> web page. They will need to submit the following documents in the application: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. An official copy of their transcript</li> <li>2. A copy of their passport photo page</li> <li>3. Proof of English proficiency</li> </ol> <p>All documents should be submitted as pdfs. Documents should not be posted to the university.</p>
<b>Visa information</b>	Exchange student will need to apply for student visa to be study on campus at UNE - see the Australian Government <a href="#">Department of Home Affairs</a> website for application details. Exchange students MUST show evidence of a Student Visa grant prior to arriving at UNE. Students who enter Australia on a visa other than a Student Visa, will not be permitted to enrol.

<b>Insurance</b>	Exchange students coming to study on-campus, they must have health insurance. It's a condition of their <a href="#">student visa</a> that they have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) that starts from the date of their arrival in Australia and finish on the date their visa expires. UNE currently has an agreement with <a href="#">Bupa</a> , a private health fund, for on-campus international students. In most cases, we will organise OSHC for the student. However, students can select an approved OSHC provider themselves and pay the insurance
