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

III NOMINATION & APPLICATION

Nomination deadlines

- Fall semester (semester one) and full academic year: 15th April 2025
- Spring semester (semester two): 1st October 2025

Partner universities should submit their nominations to incoming-exchange@univ-paris1.fr.

Application deadlines

- Fall semester (semester one) and full academic year: 1st May 2025
- Spring semester (semester two): 15th October 2025

Once our application period is open (mid-February), nominated students will receive the application procedure. They will be asked to fill in the online application form and attach the following documents: a copy of their passport, a certificate of French language proficiency, a project of learning agreement, the transcript of records, a resume and a cover letter. After the application deadline, students will receive a certificate of admission and information on the necessary steps for the online administrative registration.



COURSES



Language Requirement

Courses at Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne University are taught in French. Depending on the study cycle and academic field, some courses may also be taught in English and in Spanish. Students are expected to have at least a B2-level in the language of teaching. A language certificate or a letter from a French/English/Spanish language teacher will be asked.

Learning Agreement

In order to fill in their Learning Agreement, students can choose from a list of modules open to exchange students in their host department. In each department, an academic advisor is in charge of helping incoming exchange students with any questions related to courses. Every year leading up to the start of the fall semester (semester one) in September and the start of the spring semester (semester two) in January, orientation weeks are held for incoming students. Students will be asked to fill out an application form online that will be sent to them prior to their arrival as places are limited.

ACCOMMODATION

Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne University has some accommodation units allocated to exchange students. However, the university does not have enough accommodation to meet all demand and can therefore not guarantee any student with an offer of university accommodation.
