


The program is open to all students at Hitotsubashi.

-Our students come from over 60 different countries and regions.



## What is Hitotsubashi University Global Education Program?


- 1. Interdisciplinary Courses in English: wide varieties of subjects taught in English
- 2. Beyond Cultural Exchange: program is collaboratively developed with 5 undergraduate programs. The course subjects range from Business, Economics, Law, Social Sciences, ICT and others.
- 3. Opportunities for Japanese students and international students to learn together: designed for both international and Japanese students to participate.

HGP offers introductory to intermediate-level Japanese language courses. Besides those courses, there are many other Japanese language courses available in upper-intermediate to advanced levels.


