Rooms Type

Couple Rooms / Family Rooms

- W Undergraduate students and Japanese students etc. (including foreign nationals whose visa status is not "Student Visa") can only apply to Ikkyo-ryo.
- * Applicants cannot apply for a Single room at the same time.

Eligibility

The applicant must fulfill the following requirements.

- The applicant is a Japanese national or foreign national whose visa status is (or will be) "Student Visa", "Permanent Resident" "Long-Term Resident", or "Spouse or Child of Japanese National/Permanent Resident".
- ② The applicant is (or will be) a student at Hitotsubashi University as of Autumn 2025.
- The applicant has not exceeded the expected graduation date (enrollment period) at the time of admission.
- **X** As a rule, if you are on absence as of September 2025, you do not have eligibilities for applying.
- If you have exceeded the expected graduation date but wish to apply, please submit an explanation letter by the application deadline. For details, please see the URL below.

Occupancy Period

- a. Research students
- b. Master's degree students
- c. Professional School Programs
- d. Doctoral degree students

- 1 year (up to August 17, 2026)
- 2 years (up to August 16, 2027)
- 2 years (up to August 16, 2027)
- 3 years (up to August 15, 2028)
- All occupancy periods must not exceed the expected enrollment period at the time of admission. For those moving
 in past that date, the occupancy period will be a year.
- * For single residents, the maximum period of stay is 1 year, regardless of the course of study to which they belong.

- ① Please upload a copy of your residence card or passport page.
- ② If you will be living with your spouse or family, please upload copies of each of the following as well:
 - A) Official documentation that shows that you are married/a family.
- ♠ In case of de facto marriage, you must contact the Accommodation Section in advance and submit a copy of your certificate of residence with "wife (unregistered)" or "husband (unregistered)" in the "Relationship" column to the Accommodation Section within 14 days after moving in the dormitory, in principle. If proof of de facto marriage is not provided, permission to move in will be revoked.
- 3 As soon as you submit the application, you will receive an automated email stating your lottery number. Please contact the Accommodation Section right away of you do not receive an email immediately. Your application will not be accepted if you mention this after the application deadline.

Selection Method

Residents will be selected by **lottery**. "Students who will live with their spouse/family" will be given first priority, and students who have never lived in the International Residence Halls will be given second priority. Please put the Residence Halls in order of your preference. There is a chance that you will not be granted a room as a result of the lottery, so please make sure to have other housing options prepared.



<u>In addition to the above, residents will be charged for electricity and water</u>. There is no security deposit or key money required. Fees are subject to change in the case of a revision of budget or public fees. Please note that you may be asked to move rooms if it is found that renovation is required. An increased rent may apply in this case.

[Payment method/dates]

- ① Payment method: Automatic withdrawal from your bank account
- ② Withdrawal date for rent: The 5th day of each month
- ③ Withdrawal date for other fees: The 20th day of each month
- ④ If the withdrawal date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday, the withdrawal will take place on the next business day.

Other Information

- (1) Applications from students who fall under the following conditions will not be considered. If the following conditions are found after the student has been granted a room, the residential agreement will be terminated.
 - ① The international student's visa status changes to a status other than "Student Visa" (Please consult with the Accommodation Section in advance if you have any concerns).
 - The student has unpaid dormitory fees at the time of application, or the student fails to pay their fees within the designated time, even after being reminded by the University.
 - 3 The student has received disciplinary action from the University.

- ④ The student is no longer enrolled at Hitotsubashi University, or takes a leave of absence.
- ⑤ The student is recognized as not suitable to live in the residences due to health or sanitation issues.
- 6 The student disrupts the order of the residences.
- The student provides false information upon applying for the residence.
- The student seriously hampers the management/administration of the residences.
