


Hitotsubashi University Global Education Program

-Our students come from over 60 different countries and regions.



-Our instructors have a wide variety of international experiences.




What is Hitotsubashi University Global Education Program?


- 1. Interdisciplinary Courses in English: a wide variety of subjects taught in English





Besides those courses, there are many other Japanese language courses available in upper-intermediate to advanced levels.


