Application Form (generated in the portal) 2. Motivation Letter 3. Language Certificate (English at least minimum B2 level CEFR for courses conducted in English and Polish at least B2 level CEFR for courses conducted in Polish. Native English speakers do not need to provide any proof of their language skills) 4. Transcript of Records 5. Preliminary selected course list 5.
