# HOUSING

<b>Is housing guaranteed?</b>	On campus housing is guaranteed for all exchange students.

<b>Are meals included with housing?</b>	<p>For exchange partnerships (tuition, room and board) a meal plan is included in the program so students will receive a meal plan card that covers all three meals of the day served at any of the three cafeterias on campus. For other study abroad programs with no meal exchange component, students will have to either sign up for a meal plan of their choice at their own cost (costs will be shared during the application process) or buy meals out of pocket at the cafeterias.</p> <p>***Please note that cooking is not allowed in on campus housing. There is however a kitchen that has a fridge and microwave in every hostel</p> <p>*** Students are expected to eat from the cafeterias on campus or warm up stored food at the hostel kitchen.</p>
<b>How do I sign up for a room?</b>	Rooms are assigned to study abroad students as part of the application process. You do not need to sign up separately for your room. The type of room assigned is based on availability of room type at the time of the exchange program.
<b>How many people share a bathroom and a kitchen?</b>	2-4 people share a kitchen and bathroom, depending on your hostel and room allocation.
<b>What means of transport are available?</b>	<p>The campus is a small campus so students can walk from the hostel to classes in 2-3mins. There are shared taxis outside the school gate to get into town.</p> <p>You can also order a ride through different providers (eg: Uber, Bolt)</p>

Study Abroad Orientation	Dates and details will be communicated in offer letter.
Is the Study Abroad Orientation Mandatory?	Yes, students must arrive ahead of this date and on the arrival dates indicated in your welcome letter.
How do I register for Courses?	Your course registration is done on your behalf with your application and confirmed during the study abroad application. It is important to indicate more courses than you need in your application as back up for if you cannot get into a course you selected.

# HEALTH INSURANCE AND IMMUNIZATION

## Health Insurance

We require all study abroad students to either sign up on Ashesi's third party health insurance provider or sign up to a comprehensive plan with [Worldwide Travel Insurance Plans](#) | [Cultural Insurance Services International \(CISI\)](#) which is largely accepted in health facilities in Ghana and world wide.

## What are the immunization requirements to travel and study in Ghana?

Yellow Fever Vaccination  
Recommended: Tetanus shot  
Must have started Malaria prophylaxis and have enough for the period of exchange or a plan to cover period of exchange.



# SCHOLARSHIPS

**Is there scholarship for study abroad students to study at Ashesi?**

Ashesi provides scholarship which may cover either flight costs, housing or meal plan costs at Ashesi for **Canadian students only** to study with us for a semester.



# INDEPENDENT STUDY

**Is it possible to have an independent study as part of my study abroad at Ashesi?**

Yes. Study abroad students can indicate their independent study interests as part of their study abroad application. Once the topic for the independent study details are received and there is availability of faculty to supervise this, students will be paired with a supervisor.
